Inherrent risks of boarding at Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC). Please read & initial as accepted:

_____ Transfer of communicable parasites or an illness such as, but limited to, the canine papilloma virus (AKA puppy warts), or an upper respiratory illness such as Kennel Cough, which can be caused by a contagious bacteria or virus.

_____ Injuries, usually benign, such as broken nails, sore pads, puncture wounds, abrasions and cuts (particularly in shorter coated breeds, etc).

_____ Dogs not regularly exposed to the level of activity at Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) may feel the discomfort of sore muscles, sore joints and fatigue.

_____ Dogs not regularly exposed to outside activity or play on hard surfaces may experience sore paws, blisters, bruises or abrasions on the feet.

_____ Dogs not regularly socialized may not know how to behave politely with other dogs. These dogs are at high risk of incidents including but not limited to, bites, fights, fear aggression, object guarding, behavior problems and/or acting out.

_____ Dogs at play do get dirty. Dogs with longer hair can get matted from level of activity at Cedar Run Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC).

_____ Excessively long toenails may cause injury. You will be notified if your dog's nails are too long and must be taken care of before their next stay.

_____ I understand the extra risk my puppy has of contracting a disease or illness by entering the boarding program without being fully vaccinated.

_____ Water is available at all times; however your dog may still be thirsty after boarding. Be aware of their water intake as excessive amounts may cause and upset the stomach or other problems.

_____ Any behavior deemed dangerous or inappropriate may result in dismissal from Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC).

_____ I understand and agree that in bringing my dog to Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC), Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) has relied upon my representation that my dog has not harmed, shown aggression and/or threatening behavior towards any person or any other dog.

_____ I certify that my dog is in good health and has not been ill with any communicable diseases within the last 30 days.

_____ I have read, understand and agree to the Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) Rules & Regulations.

_____ I understand that Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) gives all dogs involved in any type of incident cursory examinations, however Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) is not liable for the location, treatment or diagnosis of any injuries incurred on our premises. It is recommended you check your dog further or seek treatment for your pet by a licensed veterinarian at your discretion.

_____ Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) and their team will not be liable for any health or behavioral problems that develop in my dog and I hereby release them of any liability of any kind, whatsoever arising from my dog's attendance and participation at Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC). I am solely responsible for any harm, including to any other dog, to the employees or invitees of Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC) or to the equipment, physical plant or other property of Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC), caused by my dog, while my dog is attending Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare (Cedar Run LLC).

Rules & Regulations

To insure the safety and health of all dogs and staff, we require all clients to comply with the following Rules & Regulations:

Safety is our top priority! Please remember that your dog will be spending time with other dogs and that their safety is our main priority. Although it is supervised play, your dog still may acquire an occasional nip or scratch.

- Each dog is required to pass a socialization interview (Meet & Greet) prior to their stay at Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare. Each dog must be non-aggressive towards other dogs or people and be non-possessive of food and toys. Owners will need to certify that their dog has not harmed or shown aggression/threatening behavior towards any person or another dog.
- Each dog must be spayed or neutered (unless under 7 months of age) prior to their stay at Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare.
- Shots: Each dog is required to be current on all vaccinations (rabies, K9 Distemper/Parvo, K9 Bordetella, K9 Influenza and a negative intestinal parasite test/fecal test within the last 12 months) as well as flea/tick prevention. Owner must provide a receipt showing shot dates obtained. It is your responsibility to provide on-going verification of current vaccinations.
- Health: Each dog must be in good health. Owners will need to certify that their dog is in good health and have been free of any conditions that could potentially jeopardize another guest. Cedar Run Dog Boarding and Daycare must be notified should your dog become ill with a communicable condition. Dogs that have been ill within the last 30 days with a communicable condition in the last 30 days will require a veterinarian certification of health in order to attend Cedar Run Dog Boarding & Daycare. If, at any time during care, a dog is noticed to have fleas and/or ticks, treatment will be applied and charged to the owner.
- Food & Dog Bed: All dog food & snacks must be stored in an airtight container. Bring enough of a dog food supply for the duration of your dog's stay unless other arrangements have been made. Please feed your dog 1 hour prior to daycare drop off so the food has time to digest. Should the owner not provide food for their dog, a 20% food fee will be added to their invoice. If a dog bed is brought, it must be machine washable and dryer safe.
- Dog Emergencies: While you are away, please notify your veterinarian who will be caring for your dog and give permission for us to call and discuss care.
- Reservations: Reservations are required. A cancellation fee may be applicable.

- If you cancel 48 hours prior to your boarding reservation, you will receive a full refund.
- If you cancel within 24 hours prior to your boarding reservation, **50%** of your payment will be refunded. This cannot be used as a credit.
- If you No-Show for your boarding reservation, you forfeit **100%** of your full payment. This cannot be used as a credit.
- **A Holiday Period is considered 2 days prior to and 2 days after the actual holiday.**
